AWANA Club meets on Wednesday night from 6:30 – 8:05pm.

Arrival: Club starts promptly at 6:30pm! Please walk your child into the sanctuary and make sure your child sits with their class. Please notify the teacher if someone other than the parent is picking your child up from club. Please pick up your child directly from the sanctuary each club night. We encourage you to arrive by 7:50pm and cheer on the children as they receive their awards for the night. Club ends by 8:05pm. Please come to the stage to pick up your child to ensure they exit safely with the appropriate person.

New to AWANA?: If tonight is your child's first night in our AWANA program, they will be bringing home a Start-Up Pamphlet/Entrance Booklet. Your child will be using this in his/her class, reviewing and memorizing the Bible verse inside, for the next 2 weeks or until complete. We encourage parents to read and review the pamphlet/booklet with your child over the remaining part of the week. Your child will love the fact that you are sharing in their AWANA experience. At the 2-week mark and if the pamplet/booklet is complete, your child will have earned their handbook, bookbag, and uniform and will be well on their way to learning God's Word!

Returning to AWANA?: If you are still in the same class as last year, please bring your handbook, bookbag, and uniform to your first AWANA Club night. We may have stored those here after last year ended, so don't worry, we will have them ready for you on the first night.

Awards: Awards are given as Bible verses are learned and handbook sections are passed off. Please take some time to review with your child to help them prepare each week for club night. This will be a big help to those children just learning to read. As a time saver, we may give out earned awards in the classroom each night. But, we will ALWAYS recognize your child on their accomplishments each club night in the sanctuary. Please come and watch as the children are recognized for their hard work in learning God's Word.
